

Campbell County Fire Department Policy		
Support Operations	Cadet Behavior & Discipline	<i>800.08</i>

I. PURPOSE:

This policy defines the appropriate behavior and the discipline procedure for the Campbell County Fire Department Cadet Program.

II. SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Cadets when representing the CCFD and the CCFD Cadet Program.

III. POLICY:

1. Behavior:

- 1.1. Cadets must live a law-abiding life.
- 1.2. Cadets must be honest with their fellow Cadets and other department personnel.
- 1.3. Cadets wearing CCFD attire must act in a professional manner as representatives of CCFD. CCFD attire includes anything with the department name or logo.
- 1.4. Cadets involved in an illegal action are responsible for informing the Cadet Coordinator as soon as possible.
- 1.5. Cadets involved with the Juvenile Probation Program will be terminated from the Cadet program. .
- 1.6. The use of tobacco products is prohibited for all Cadets.
- 1.7. Inappropriate language is not permitted.
- 1.8. Cadets must maintain department confidentiality including information about an emergency scene and the individuals involved.
- 1.9. Cadets will be allowed to participate in chaperoned Cadet trips; all other CCFD out-of-town travel is prohibited.

2. Discipline:

- 2.1. The Cadet Coordinator will discipline Cadets violating CCFD or CCFD Cadet Policies.
- 2.2. Termination from the CCFD Cadet Program will be evaluated by a Division Chief on an individual basis.
- 2.3. Disciplinary issues not covered under the Cadet Policies will be covered by CCFD Policies.
